HARDSHIP FUND

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The Marist Auckland Waterpolo Hardship Fund is provided by the Club to help Marist players who are experiencing genuine and unavoidable financial difficulties and are struggling to pay Club costs.

This fund is discretionary. It is intended to assist with any relevant player club costs. This includes but is not limited to support for training fees, uniform and tournament costs.

Who can apply?

Any registered Marist Auckland Waterpolo Club player.

How to apply?

The player or their caregiver must complete the Hardship Fund application form and provide it to the Age Group Co-ordinator or the Club Treasurer. Clearly state why you are applying, and what support is requested. Applications need to be re-submitted annually.

Who assesses the applications?

Applications are confidential and will be considered by the Club Captain, the Club Treasurer, and the Age Group Co-ordinator who will advise the player or their caregiver of the outcome of the application.

Other forms of assistance available.

From time to time, Marist Auckland Waterpolo Club families express interest in supporting a player who is experiencing hardship. While the application form is confidential, and the player's name will not be shared, the support requested, and the reason may be discussed with one of these families.
